Notice is hereby given that **Nicola Lakeshore Water Utility** has made application to the Comptroller of Water Rights for his/her consent to the filing under the provisions of the *Water Utility Act* and the *Utilities Commission Act* of rates and charges for service. A summary of the proposed rates is as follows:

The rate increase is to generate sufficient revenue to cover the cost of increased operating expenses and set aside sufficient monies in the Replacement Reserve Trust Fund("RRTF"). \$28,500 will be set aside in Replacement Reserve Trust Fund every year.
