TO ALL LOT OWNERS:

A discussion with a resident resulted in us installing an activated carbon filter on our blower room fan in the Operations Building. The initial results are positive (please see the attached Ops Building photo).

On the same topic, we have completed the purging of the treated irrigation reservoir and are now ready to run fresh water through lines. We are asking all lot owners to run irrigation lines for a minimum of 15 minutes to assist in flushing the distribution system.

We are continuing to make adjustments to bio cells to tweak operations and have sent off samples to determine the state of bug activity that is key to an effective operation.

I again ask for cooperation in the administration of garbage for our site. We are having problems with people NOT reading what is acceptable as recycling and waste. Just because you add some paper or plastic into a paper bag of yard waste, clippings, needles, etc, it does not qualify as recycling (please see the attached Waste photos). It is also not garbage. It is to be dropped off at the appropriate area, accessed from the upper gravel road at the highest point of our property in the southwest corner (please see the attached Sketch Plan). There is a material storage area AND a clipping, branches area that will be burned this winter.

To the party who is ignoring the rules and placing yard waste in either the recycling or waste containers, when we determine whom the party is, we will be charging that party for the full cost of removal of the container to Kelowna. You are warned!

We all do not want the cost of a staffed site. PLEASE do your part in this process.

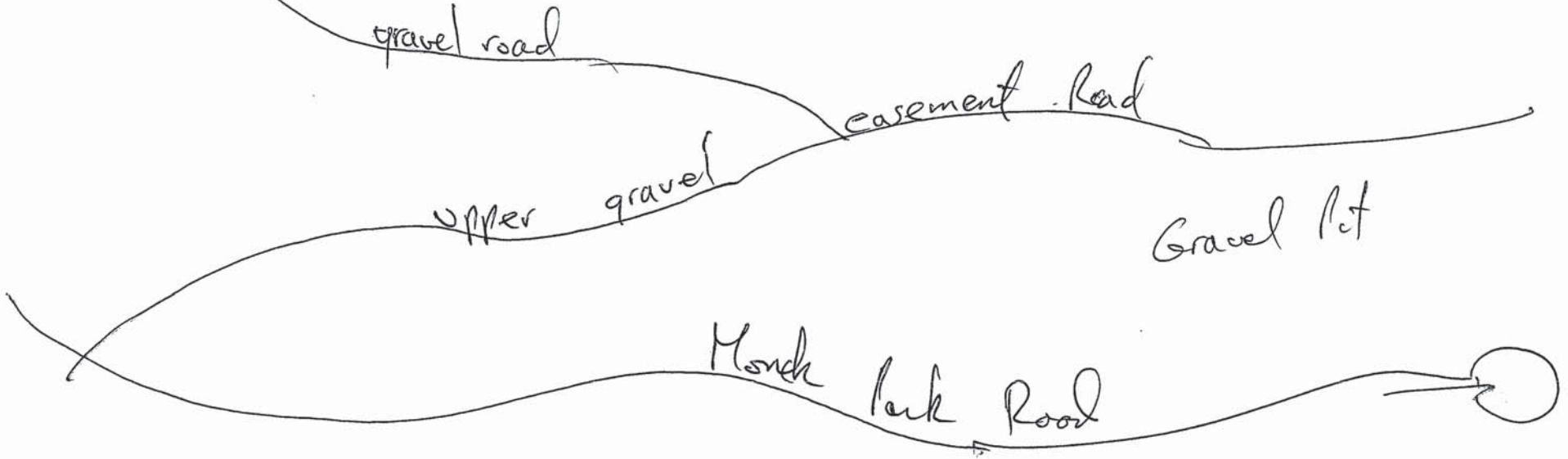
