TO ALL LOT OWNERS AT NICOLA LAKESHORE ESTATES

You will note on our website, a Power Point presentation provided by the Thompson Nicola Regional District, on the solid waste management plan, which is planned for the TNRD for implementation in June, 2008 and January 1, 2009.

You will also note that the implementation of tipping fees will start June 2008 for construction waste and January 1, 2009 for residential waste. At the same time, recycling will be used as a waste diversion stream at specified waste sites (Lower Nicola Solid Waste Dump).

Currently Nicola Lakeshore Water Utility Co. Ltd. has a single pick up point at the operations building, with no waste diversion or recycling program. This will be changing over the next few months, with the introduction of containers for mixed recyclables, paper, tin, cardboard and glass, with the balance of the waste being conventional destined for the land fill. In the end, the handling of waste will go up. At a minimum, the cost of tipping fees will result in an increase in garbage fees per lot/house.

We need your help to start to plan to reduce solid waste hauled to the dump. We continue to request that your contractors not use the residential waste containers to dispose of construction waste. Please pick up after yourselves and do not leave bags outside of the containers. Please do request your construction contractors to haul construction debris with covered trailers or decks. We are getting a lot of waste along side of our road.

Stay tuned for changes as we know about them.
